Speaker: George Magnus, author and broadcaster

This talk will address issues in China today, particularly the tensions between China and liberal leaning democracies and the implications for the UK.

The speaker has served as Chief economist at SG Warburg and then worked 20 years at the Swiss bank, UBS. Since leaving UBS in 2016, he became a research associate at Oxford University's China Centre and at the SOAS China Institute in London. He appears regularly on the BBC, and Bloomberg, and in written media such as the FT, Times, Telegraph, Guardian, Spectator, Prospect and New Statesman. His most recent book, Red Flags: why Xi's China is in Jeopardy, is available at most bookshops.
