In March 2019, 2021, 2022 and 2023, Cara was named one of the NHS's top 50 Chief Executives. In June 2019, Cara was appointed Honorary Colonel of 243 (the Wessex) Multi-Role Medical Regiment, part of the Army Medical Services.
